

RULES OF USING SĄDOWA STATION BY CARRIERS AND OTHER USERS

1. The following are entitled to enter the area of Sądowa Station:

- a) Buses of Carriers/Operators upon fulfilment of paragraph 5,
- b) Vehicles of the Police, Road Transport Inspectorate, Military Police, Border Guard, Fire Department, Ambulance Service and other public services,
- c) Vehicles of entitled employees of the Sądowa Station Logistics Operator, KZGM, MZUiM,
- d) Other vehicles authorised by the Sądowa Station Logistics Operator.

2. Traffic participants present in the area of Sądowa Station are subject to the provisions of the Traffic Law Act of 20 June 1997 and the provisions of these Rules.

3. Detailed traffic rules and any arrangements concerning the use of Sądowa Station shall be agreed with the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator.

4. It is forbidden to place any announcements, information, advertisements and timetable signs on the area of Sądowa Station without the appropriate consent of the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator.

5. In order for the Carrier/Operator to use Sądowa Junction, it is necessary to conclude an agreement with the City of Katowice through the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator under the following conditions:

- a) the Carrier/Operator has an up-to-date timetable attached to a document issued by the relevant organiser or authority (certificate, confirmation of notification, permit) and has made it available to the Sądowa Station Logistics Operator;
- b) the Carrier/Operator obeys the traffic rules established by the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator and the orders given by the authorized representatives of the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator or persons authorized by them while using the station infrastructure, including, in justified cases, obeying the orders to turn off the bus engine while parked at the arrival/departure stands of Sądowa Station. In particular, the Carrier/Operator is obliged to comply with the order to change the arrival/departure stand given by authorised representatives of the Sądowa Station Logistics Operator or persons authorised by them;
- c) the Carrier/Operator shall provide the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator with a timetable in the required format (Excel file in the structure provided by the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator).

6. The Carrier/Operator acknowledges that in case of a malfunction of the bus on the area of Sądowa Station or on the access roads leading to the station, the Carrier/Operator is obliged to immediately report the malfunction to the personnel of Sądowa Station and to tow the vehicle away from the station within 2 hours from the immobilisation. If the vehicle is not towed within this period, the Sądowa Station Logistic Operator is entitled to tow it to the nearest place where such a vehicle can be parked on a public road.
